



Sailboat Requirements

- Courses are predominantly given in Topaz and Lasers. **Sail numbers** are required on main.
- **Each sailor should have their own sailboat from Start Sailing onward.** If on Start Sailing or Basic Skills, you can **share** a double-handed sailboat (such as a Topaz **with a jib**) with someone doing the same level, **subject to Covid restrictions.**
- Topaz dinghies can be rented from the club on a first come, first serve basis.
- You **cannot** sail on the course without a sailboat and there is **no refund of course fee** if you arrive without a sailboat.
- Your sailboat, any detachable parts of the boat, trolley, and cover must be **clearly labeled with your name.**
- Your sailboat must have **adequate pleasure craft/marine insurance** with minimum 3rd party insurance of 3 million euro.

Terms & Conditions

Parental Consent

I accept that no liability is attached to Baltimore Sailing Club, it's members or servants for any loss or damage to property or injury sustained by any cadet enrolled for tuition and that the Club will not accept liability for damage to dinghies on the sailing courses. I have read and accepted the above and confirm that any boat used on the courses has insurance cover.

Payment Policy

Payment for courses is required at the time of booking online. A booking confirmation will be sent by email once this has been processed.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations for the courses prior to the 1st May will be given 60% refund of the total course fee. Thereafter NO REFUND will apply except in the event of a medically certified case whereupon 50% refund of course fee will apply.
